



HIGHWAY MAP




PROPERTY DETAILS

LOCATION	The subject farm is located approximately 36 miles west of Chicago O'Hare International Airport and is contiguous to the village of Maple Park. Nearby cities include: Cortland (1 1/8 miles west), Sycamore (3 5/8 miles northwest), and DeKalb (4 1/4 miles west).			
FRONTAGE	There is approximately 3/4 mile of road frontage on Pleasant Street and 1/2 mile on East County Line Road.










PLAT MAP




